

## 2016 April HSK Test at UNL-CI

HSK is a standardized Chinese proficiency test to measure the ability of non-native Chinese speakers to communicate in Chinese in daily life, academic and working settings. It is officially administered by the Confucius Institute Headquarters (Hanban) in Beijing, China. The test results are used to select participants for Confucius Institute Scholarships and the Summer Camp candidates. In addition, it is a plus for career building.

The Confucius Institute (CI) at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln is a test center for HSK and holds the test twice each year. Any person interested is welcome to register and participate in the test. The upcoming test at UNL Confucius Institute is on April 16, 2016.

HSK consists of 6 levels. Each candidate can select a suitable level to register. The test fee for each level is different (See the table below). The students taking Chinese courses at CI will be entitled to a 50% discount on the test fee once the test has been completed.

HSK Test Level Fees

1. **The deadline to register is March 20, 2016.**
2. Log on at <http://www.chinesetest.cn>. Practice tests are accessible on this website as well.
3. Choose the test center—Confucius Institute, UNL and the test date of April 16, 2016.
4. Fill in your personal information for registration and submit to complete the process.

### To pay the Test Fee:

Once online registration is complete, please mail the test fee either by check or cashier's check, made payable to UNLCI, to Mikki Sandin at UNL-Confucius Institute. **Fee must be received at UNLCI within one week after registration deadline in order to order the tests from Hanban.**
